

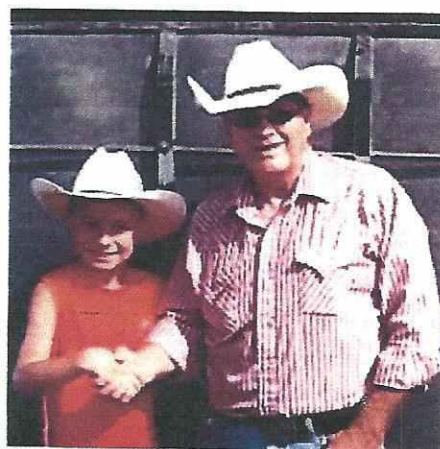
The following MTRA members are running for the five (5) Board of Director seats which need to be filled in 2018. These incumbents are listed in alphabetical order.
